Improving Home Insulation

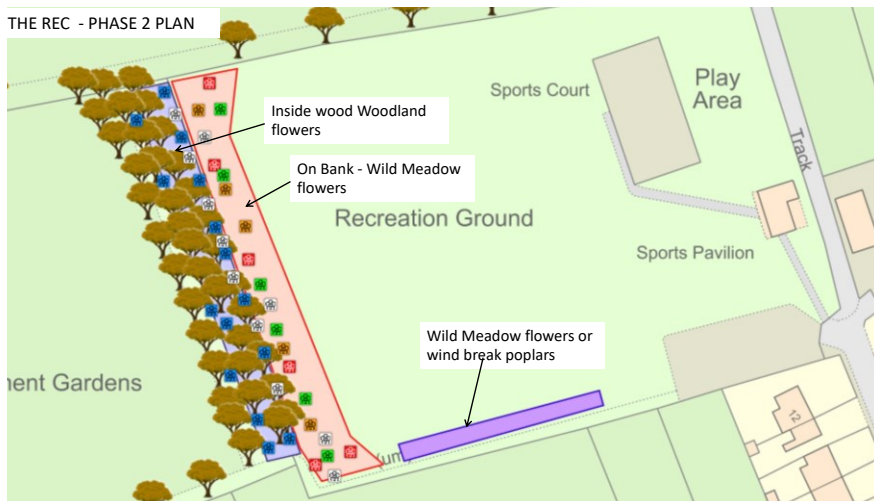
South Somerset District Council have recently purchased two infra-red cameras which will allow people to see where heat is escaping from their homes. They are lending this equipment to Parish Councils. We are currently on a waiting list and have requested a demonstration of this equipment, hopefully in October/November.

Proposed Felling of Leylandii at the Recreation Field

It is proposed to remove the leylandii on the west and south side of the rec in September as they are becoming unsafe. This will be discussed again at the council meeting on 18th July.

The plan below shows phase 2 of our proposed rec refurbishment.



- WEST WINDBREAK WOOD. Clear undergrowth and encourage tree growth. Plant with woodland flowers
- BANK. Make good the bank and plant with wildflowers. Area to be used as seating areas
- SOUTH SIDE. We are looking to see if there is a need/requirement to have a wind break hedge / tree line in front of the footpath or plant a strip of wild flowers
